Course Information: This IFSI training is an opportunity for firefighters to sharpen their skills during live fire evolutions. The class will concentrate on the basic skills and techniques for fighting fires in single family dwellings and commercial buildings. Emphasis will be placed on size-up, search techniques, building construction, and the responsibility of the Engine Company and Truck Company when responding to these types of fires.

This One Day Class will cover the core Essentials of your Firefighting Skills. Students must be able to participate in ALL Live Fire Evolutions. Topics to be covered include:

Engine Company Operations
Truck Company Operations
Squad Company Operations
SCBA Confidence
Fire Officer Development

Students must supply Bunker Gear and SCBA. There will be a short Lunch Break between evolutions. We recommend bringing your own lunch. Maximum class size – 35.
