SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

In cooperation with the Northern Illinois Fire Sprinkler Advisory Board (NIFSAB) and the Illinois Fire Chiefs Educational & Research Foundation, a scholarship program has been made possible to attend a two-day educational seminar on residential fire sprinkler system topics on September 20 & 21, 2008, in Minneapolis, Minnesota.
