Who Should Attend? Both *new* and *experienced* fire protection district officials, including trustees, fire chiefs, and attorneys will benefit from these programs.

Purpose: To provide fire district officials a full understanding of their duties, the timetable for performing such duties and the legal requirements for operation of a fire protection district. In addition, the training sessions provide updates on the recent legislative efforts and updates from key organizations among the fire service.

Advanced Trustee Training Continuing Education Requirement

Trustees who have completed the 3-Part Advanced Trustee Training (ATT) in compliance with PA 95-0799 in 2009 have until the end of 2010 to meet the yearly three hour continuing education requirement. Attendance at an Administrative Training Session has been approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshal and will meet the continuing education requirement for 2010. [The annual Administration Training Sessions (ATS) should not be confused with Parts 1, 2 or 3 of the Advanced Trustee Training (ATT) which are offered separately. Unless otherwise announced, the ATT sessions will again be presented in conjunction with the IAFFD Annual Conference to be held June 10-13, 2010 in Peoria.]
