Huntley Fire Protection District



The Huntley Fire Protection District has completed construction of their new Headquarters Station located at 11118 East Main Street in Huntley. The station replaces the original district station which was built in 1958. Since 1958 the original station went through several renovations to accommodate the growing district. With steady growth and the increasing demands on the Fire District, the new station was developed on property the District already owned and was occupied by their maintenance division.

A building committee, comprised of members across all ranks, developed a vision for the future and promoted its growth. The new station incorporated office space for the current administration with additional office space for future growth. Additional features include a conference room which can accommodate 14 members and a training room which can seat 76 with large screen TV monitors surrounding the room. Adjacent to the training room is an ambulance simulation lab which includes the back of an ambulance, control room and residential simulation room.

The Station will also house a Battalion Chief and Quick Response Vehicle. All trailers, reserve apparatus and staff vehicles will be stored on the bay floor with a drive through bay. At the rear of the building are three maintenance bays that can accommodate all sizes and types of apparatus.

In addition to normal operations, special considerations for safety or our members were considered. A built in infra-red sauna was installed in the fitness room, positive pressure ventilation in all gear storage rooms, a gear washing machine and a SCBA Decon washer.
